Проверяются лексико-грамматические навыки на момент окончания 10 класса. «Лексико-грамматический» блок предполагает проверку знаний на понимание признаков изученных грамматических явлений, видовременных форм глаголов, модальных глаголов, артиклей, существительных, прилагательных, местоимений, предлогов. Учащиеся должны знать, понимать основные значения изученных единиц, основные способы словообразования, основные нормы речевого этикета, реплики-клише, принятые в стране изучаемого языка.



Критерии оценивания и перевод баллов в оценку по пятибальной шкале.

Оценка «отлично» - речь воспринимается легко, произношение слов и интонационные контуры без нарушения нормы, допускается не более трёх фонетических ошибок, в том числе одна ошибка, искажающая смысл.

Оценка «хорошо» - речь воспринимается достаточно легко, присутствуют немногочисленные необоснованные паузы, допускается не более пяти фонетических ошибок, в том числе две ошибки, искажающие смысл.

Оценка «удовлетворительно»- речь воспринимается с трудом, интонационные контуры незначительно нарушены, имеются 2-3 необоснованные паузы, допускается не более семи ошибок, в том числе три ошибки, искажающие смысл.

18-20 баллов (оценка «отлично»): коммуникативная задача решена полностью, текст логично выстроен, правильно разделен на абзацы, допускается не более 2-х лексико-грамматических ошибок и не более 2-х орфографических ошибок.

12-17 баллов (оценка «хорошо»): коммуникативная задача в целом решена, текст не всегда логичен (не более двух ошибок при использовании средств логической связи), допускается не более четырех лексико-грамматических ошибок и не более четырех орфографических ошибок.

7-11 баллов (оценка «удовлетворительно»): коммуникативная задача решена частично, имеются нарушения в структурном оформлении текста, допущены не более двух логических ошибок, не более пяти лексико-грамматических ошибок и не более пяти орфографических ошибок.

6 баллов и менее (оценка «неудовлетворительно»): задание не выполнено (не решена коммуникативная задача или объем не соответствует требуемому), текст выстроен нелогично, отсутствует деление на абзацы, допущено шесть и более лексико-грамматических ошибок и пять и более орфографических.

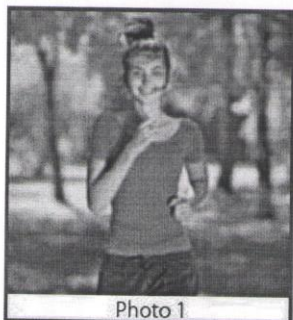

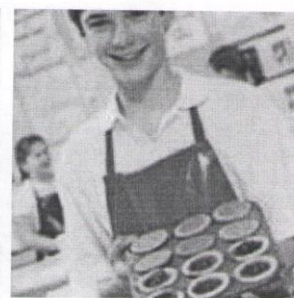

Оценка «отлично» - коммуникативная задача решена полностью, раскрыты все аспекты задания, имеются вступительная и заключительная фразы, дано не менее 10 развернутых предложений, высказывание связно и логично, ошибки практически отсутствуют (не более двух ошибок, не препятствующих коммуникации). Фонетические ошибки практически отсутствуют.

Оценка «хорошо» - коммуникативная задача в целом решена, но 1 аспект не раскрыт или 2 аспекта раскрыты не полностью, дано не менее 8 развернутых предложений, высказывание не вполне связно и логично, отсутствует вступительная или заключительная фраза, сделано не более четырех ошибок, в том числе не более двух ошибок, препятствующих коммуникации. Сделано не более трех фонетических ошибок.

Оценка «удовлетворительно» - коммуникативная задача решена частично (полностью раскрыт только один аспект), дано не менее шести предложений, высказывание в целом имеет завершенный характер, но допущены ошибки в использовании средств логической связи, сделано не

более пяти ошибок и не более двух препятствующих коммуникации.
Наличие не более пяти фонетических ошибок, в том числе две ошибки, препятствующие коммуникации.

Оценка «неудовлетворительно» - речь воспринимается с большим трудом, не раскрыт ни один аспект темы, высказывание несвязно и нелогично, сделано более пяти ошибок и более двух, препятствующих коммуникации.

There is a famous saying by a great writer Aldous Huxley that says it doesn't matter what you experience, only what you do with what you've experienced matters. So, what does it mean and to what extent can these words be called true?

In my opinion, these are very wise words and I totally agree with them. First of all, there is a huge difference between experiencing something and actually learning from it. For example, it doesn't matter how many books you read because they contain only information and not knowledge.
